Youth House Nové Město pod Smrkem to share good practices and bring them from Italy to the Czech Republic. In Nové Město pod Smrkem live less than 4,000 inhabitants. Young people do not have many possibilities to travel abroad and meet people from different countries and cultures so the idea is to bring all these aspects in the town.

The project is implemented by Czech Youth Programme the Duke of Edinburgh's Award in cooperation with InformaGiovani, Fondazione Giovanni and Francesca Falcone and thanks to the financial support of the Daphne program.

ACCOMMODATION:

You will be hosted in wooden cottages next to the Youth house. Bunk beds are available. It may happen that male and female volunteers need to share the same room (4 volunteers in each cottage). The house is equipped with electricity, running water, kitchen and bathroom.



FOOD:

Participants will cook together in the Youth house. Please let your camp leader know if you have any special needs regarding food (vegetarian/vegan, allergies, no pork etc.)

WORK:

You will be involved in maintenance work in the Youth House garden or the Camp base near the Youth House. It could be painting the roofs of the cottages, manual work in the garden, preparing ground for electricity cables

STUDY PART AND FREE TIME:

You will have the opportunity to link with the local community not only going to the Youth house in Nove Mesto pod Smrkem. There will be 1 – 2 days of activities at local schools aiming to intercultural interaction. During your free time there will be various possibilities for you.

- There are many artistic workshops in the Youth house.
- There are many interesting places to visit in the region such as Frydlant Castle, Hejnice Castle, Spa resort in Libverda, Mountain Smrk, city of Liberec (Zoo, botanical garden, Jested hill with cableway, ...)
- Also excursions can be organized to nearby places such as distillery, cider making, open air museum
- Besides that physical training can be done, there is a hall with indoor climbing, swimming in the reservoir or swimming pool, mountain biking, horse riding, beekeeping ...



Please note that expenses for trip ARE NOT COVERED by the organization and if you decide to organize with the group you have to pay food by yourself and contribute for gasoline of the van.

LANGUAGE OF THE CAMP:

The camp language will be English. Some knowledge of Czech is appreciated.

WHAT TO BRING:

- Don't forget a sleeping bag and working clothes, also good shoes are useful for the mountains.
- If you play any music instrument, you can bring it with you!
- Also food from your country, games, music, dances, dresses and other things to be shared with the group from your country not only for the international evening
- If you are from the European Union, don't forget to get the European Health Insurance Card that will facilitate your access to the Health System in case of need.

HOW TO GET TO NOVE MESTO POD SMRKEM:

The transport will be agreed individually according to the arrival.

Option 1 (you would like to go straight to Nové Město pod Smrkem from the airport (Terminal 1, Terminal 2))

You take the bus 100 to the Metrostation Zličín (15min), you change there to Metro yellow line B, you go to final stop Černý Most, (about 40minutes), you will find the busses going to the city Liberec (about 1hour), there you take the train at railwaystation directly to Nové Město pod Smrkem (about 1hour).

Option 2 (you would like to visit centre of Prague)

By taking bus 119 from Terminal 1 or 2 and go to go to station Dejvická (last stop) change for metro Metro green line and go to Můstek with this metro, or like in Option 1 take the bus 100 to Metrostation Zličín and then go continue with yellow line B to Metrostation Můstek, this station is on both lines, always get to the Metrostation Černý Most with yellow line B, it is the border of Prague to get the bus to Liberec and to Nové Město pod Smrkem.

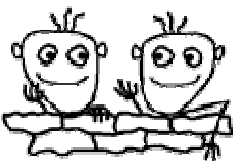
